Why do we value the quality of a literary work? In my experience, there are two big reasons why we decide to read, or reject reading, a work: the text itself and the subject matter it represents. Take, for instance, this week's episode of our podcast. The host, Gabi Palmer, had to deal with some exigent circumstances – such as the having to leave her house at a moment's notice and live in a hostel with several fellow authors – and she ended up traveling to a tiny country village in the Swiss Alps to do an interview. The end result is an excellent episode with author Ullas Bagrodia, a writer and "icon" of the book publishing world, and the host left with a better understanding of the publishing industry and a greater appreciation for the difficulties that authors have when they embark on this journey. We value literature and the quality of a work because, despite having to suspend disbelief, we are enthralled by the story that is told. And we want to learn more about the things we read, to find out how it got there. But, at the end of the day, it doesn't really matter if a book is good or bad, right or wrong. All that matters is that we find what we are looking for, and no other book can fill that hole. Yes, there are good and bad books. There are sad books and uplifting books and even books that leave a bad taste in the reader's mouth. But what really matters is the feeling we leave with, not the book itself.
